Energising Avonmouth

New Earth is currently building a 13MW low-carbon renewable energy recovery plant at Avonmouth, to be co-located with the existing waste treatment facility. New Earth's construction partner for the project, Dean and Dyball, are on programme to complete the build of the sheds that will house the plant in mid-march. The steel frames and concrete floors are complete and cladding of the building is underway, as is the electrical fit out.

Scott Edmondson, New Earth's Technical Director, and his team are scheduled to begin the installation of the New Earth Advanced Thermal (NEAT) technology in March, starting with twin overhead gantry cranes to manoeuvre the NEAT modular units into place.

The winter weather has not delayed the programme on site and the energy recovery plant will be completed by spring 2013 with the first electricity being exported in winter 2012 .
